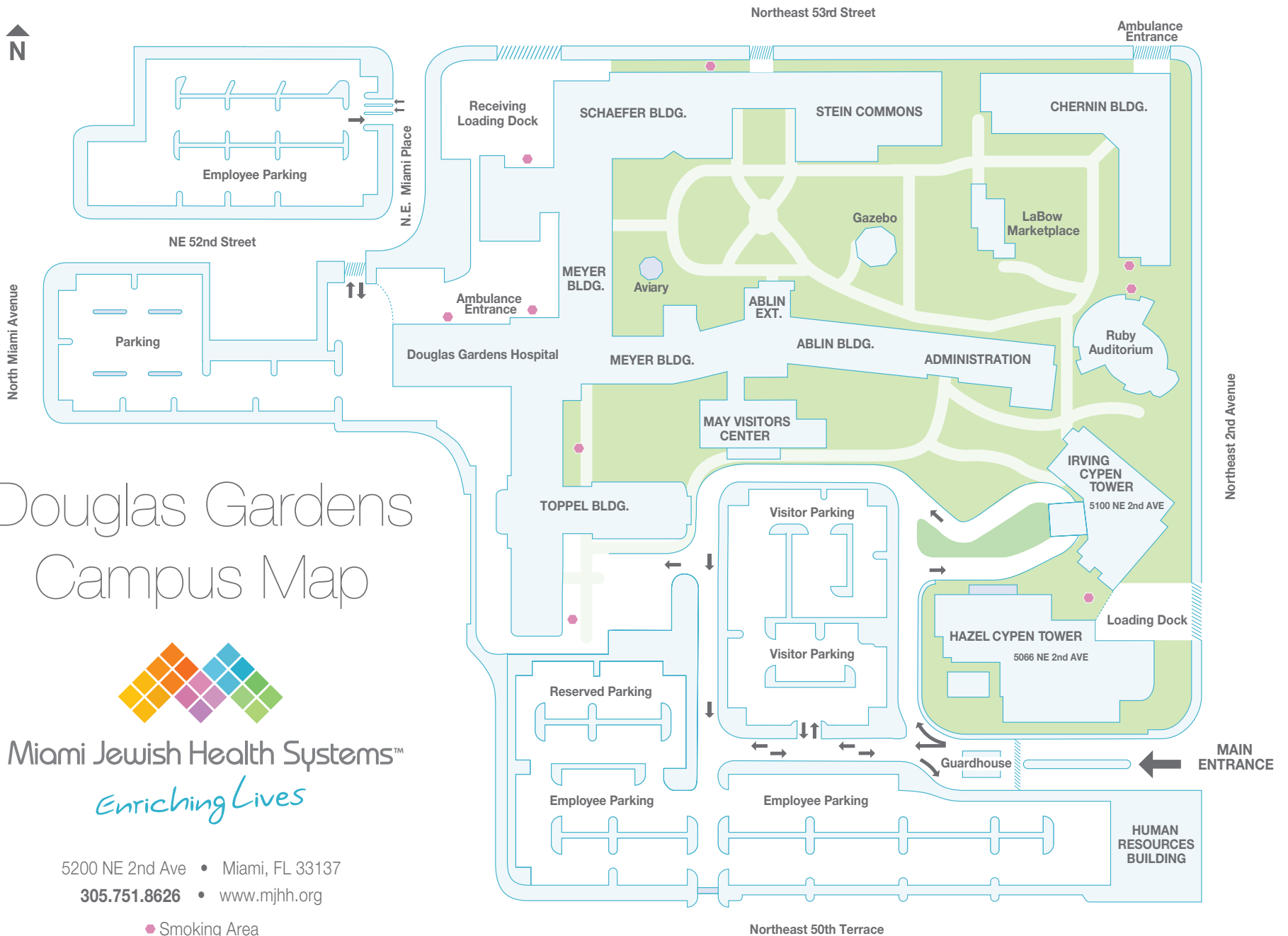

FOOD & BEVERAGE

- **CAFETERIA, EXT. 2217**
Our cafeteria is located off the lobby in Irving Cypen Tower (ICT) and is open daily from 7:45am - 9:30am for breakfast, and from 11am – 2pm for lunch. Dinner is not served in the cafeteria.
- **ICE CREAM PARLOR, EXT. 2384**
Our olde fashioned Ice Cream Parlor is located in the May Visitors Center and is open daily from 8am - 4pm, for breakfast and treats.
- **VENDING MACHINES**
Soda machines are located outside the ICT cafeteria, behind the Ruby Auditorium, and in the LaBow Marketplace lobby. Soda and snack machines can be found behind the May Visitors Center, in the nurse's lounge on 2 Toppel North, behind the 1 Meyer nursing station, and at the north end of 1 Meyer.

SUNDRIES

- **LaBow GIFT SHOP, EXT. 2532**
The LaBow Gift Shop is open Monday through Friday from 10:30am - 4pm, and Sundays from 12pm - 4pm. You can find a variety of gift items including perfume, jewelry, handbags, clothing, greeting cards, and much more.
- **ICT CONVENIENCE STORE**
There is a small convenience store off the Irving Cypen Tower lobby which sells staples such as milk, juice, aspirin, cereal, cookies, etc. It is open Monday through Friday from 12pm - 2:45pm.
- **NEWSPAPERS**
Miami Herald vending machines can be found behind the May Visitors Center.

GROOMING SERVICES

- **HCT BEAUTY PARLOR, EXT. 3831**
The Hazel Cypen Tower Beauty Parlor is open Tuesday through Saturday from 8:30am – 5pm. Services include haircuts, permanents, color, manicures, pedicures, etc. A price list is available in the lobby.

LABOW BEAUTY SHOP, EXT. 2534

The services of the Beauty Shop in the LaBow Marketplace are available to long-term residents only. For hours of operation, appointments, and prices please call ext. 3831. This salon offers haircuts, permanents, color and wash and set. If a resident needs services in their room, the nursing staff can make those arrangements.

COMMUNICATIONS

- **PHONES**
