MIAMI JEWISH HEALTH OPENS IN HIALEAH

Miami Jewish Health Systems (MJHS) has branched out to Hialeah with the opening of its Programs for All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) center.

Located at 60 E. Third St., the PACE center is the first of three planned for Miami-Dade County in the coming years, President and CEO Jeffrey Freimark said. His nonprofit runs the largest nursing home in Miami, and also has a PACE center on its main campus.

The PACE center will bus in patients who need daily assistance, but are still able to live independently. This should cost Medicare about one-third as much as it would to put the patients in nursing homes, MJHS stated.
