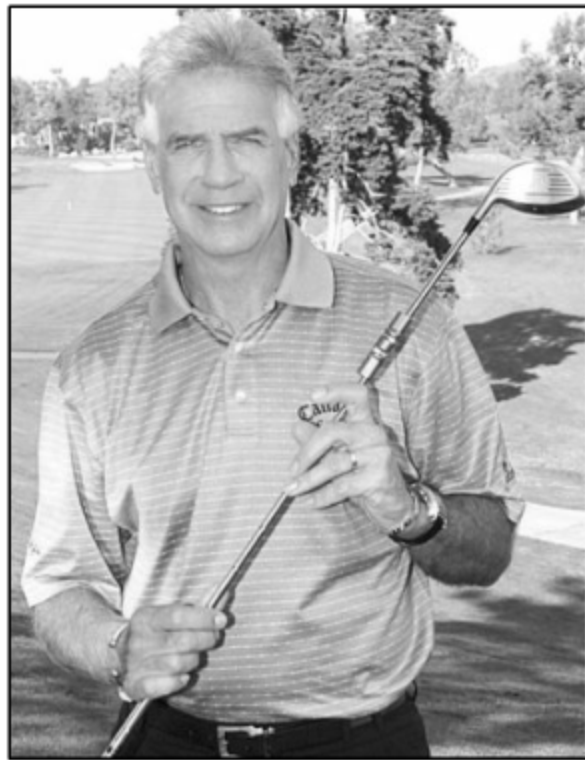


## Miami Jewish Health Systems hosts 2011 Douglas Gardens Classic Golf Tournament
